Who is eligible to get the H1N1 influenza shot?

This vaccine is for:

- ✓ 6 months old to 24 years old.
- ✓ Women who are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- ✓ Caregivers of children 6 months old or younger.
- ✓ Healthcare workers and first responders.



Why are only certain groups of people allowed to get the H1N1 vaccine at this time?

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has prioritized groups of people who have the highest risk for complications from the H1N1 influenza.

When will the others be able to get the vaccine?

We will vaccinate the general public as more vaccine is produced and made available.
