JOB SUMMARY Under general supervision of the Weber County Sheriff's Office, reports to a predetermined location and helps children cross the roadway in the safest possible manner. ESSENTIAL DUTIES (Any one position may not include all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all duties which may be found in positions of this class.) Assists children and pedestrians in crossing the street safely. Turns pedestrian traffic lights on and off, if applicable. Makes sure the lights are functioning as they should be. Is on location to function as a crossing guard in the morning, midday, and afternoon, or as requested/required. Reports all problems and potential problems to supervisor. Reviews the area for dangerous or abnormal circumstances, such as weather. Obtains vehicle and driver descriptions for reporting motorist violations to supervisor for further action. Builds rapport with principals for reporting of disruptive children.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS High school graduation or equivalent and No experience required.

Working knowledge of essential duties, as listed. Some knowledge of pedestrian road safety. Ability to communicate effectively with pedestrians and the driving public. Ability to use good judgment in determining when it is safe to cross the road. Able to work well with children. Ability to deal tactfully, but firmly, with the public to effectively report traffic violations, adhere to rules and policies for crossing guards. Ability to rapidly analyze various situations, and think and act quickly in emergency situations.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS *Must be able to respond to job site within 15 minutes of notification.* Must be able to set up traffic cones and turn on school zone flashing lights, as required. Must be able to stand and walk across two and/four lane highways or roadways for approximately 45 minutes at a time. Good hearing and eyesight are required to hear and see emergency vehicles, oncoming traffic, and school children. Corrective lenses and hearing aids are acceptable. Valid Utah drivers license or reliable transportation. Submit to and pass a background investigation. Willing and able to work outside in all weather conditions. Experience in working with children preferred.
